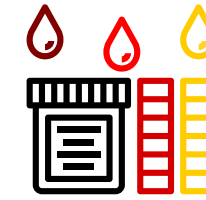
ETCH Nephrology & Hypertension Practice

- CKD (chronic kidney disease)
- Fluid & Electrolytes disorders
- Glomerulonephritis
- Elevated blood pressure/hypertension
- Urinary symptoms, nocturnal enuresis
- Kidney stones

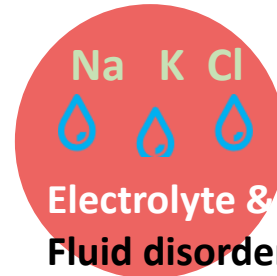

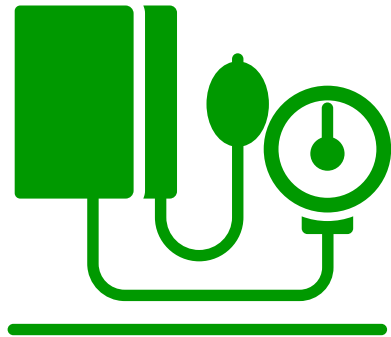

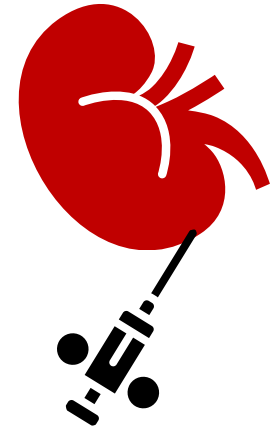
Nephrology Practice – Procedures

The Division of Pediatric Nephrology and Hypertension we provide various *procedures*:

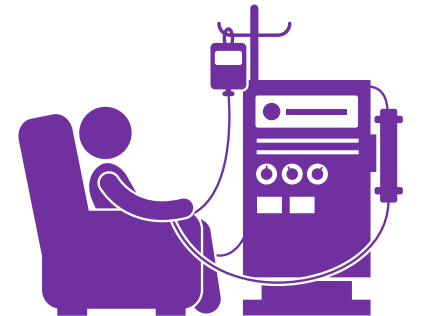
- 24-hour ABPM (Ambulatory BP monitor)

Practice Manager for Nephrology, Urology & Gynecology

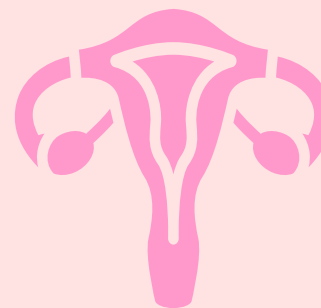
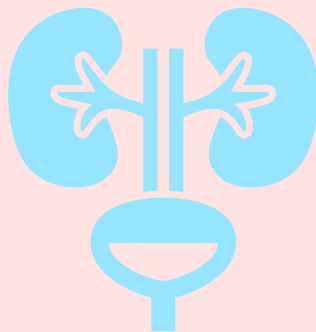
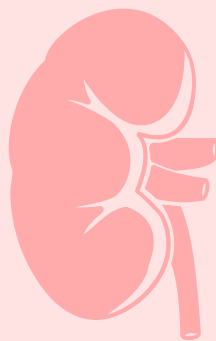
